



## Evaluation criteria for the admission at the PhD in Social and Development Psychology, and Educational Research (XXXIII cycle)

Required documentation (in Italian or English): a) TITLES. 1. Academic Curriculum (List of exams taken and respective marks/grades). 2. Curriculum vitae, indicating, where present, also research experience (including thesis) 3. List of publications (including communications or posters presented at conferences). 4. Declaration of Certification and Act Notoriety (D.P.R.445 / 2000 Art. 46 and 47). b) RESEARCH PROJECT. Short research project (Maximum 1000 words, excluding title and bibliography) concerning one of the two curricula of the PhD. The documentation must be received by 12.00 am on **4/9/2017**: 1) by email (at [didatticadip38@uniroma1.it](mailto:didatticadip38@uniroma1.it)) indicating in the subject of the mail a) the name and surname of the candidate and b) the curriculum (SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY OR DEVELOPMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY AND EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH). Documents must be sent as pdf and can not exceed the size of 5MB; 2) Alternatively, documents requested can be sent via ordinary post addressing to the Dipartimento di Psicologia dei Processi di Sviluppo e Socializzazione – Dottorato XXXII Ciclo, 3° Piano, st. 320, Via dei Marsi, 78, 00185, Roma. Within the postal parcel must be specified the curriculum (SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY or DEVELOPMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY AND EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH). The parcel must be received by the secretariat of the department by 12:00 pm of 4/9/2017.

*Titles, project and oral exam will be evaluated according to the following evaluation grid:*

**1. Titles (up to 7 points)**

1.1 Bachelor's Degree (Master's, Specialist or Single-cycle Degree - max 5 points)

**2. Project (max 23 points)**

For the selection, the candidate submit a project that assess the applicant's inclination for the research and its ability to independently design and organize the different steps of the project. The project should not exceed the maximum length of 1000 words (excluded title and bibliography). The project presented is not an obligation for the research activities during the PhD program.

**3. Oral (max 30 points)**

Will be admitted to the oral only the candidates who have at least 15/30 points in the evaluation of the titles and the project. The oral in anime to explore, through an interview, the theoretical topics addressed in the research project presented during the submission of the application, Further discussion topics will cover the candidate's competences and previous curricular experiences. Language: ITALIAN or ENGLISH. Results publication on the web site "<http://dip38.psi.uniroma1.it/notizie/avvisi>" within **28/9/2017**

The minimum overall score for admission to the PhD is 30/60.
