Eleonora Cannoni is Associate Professor, SSD M-PSI/04 (Developmental and Educational Psychology) in the Faculty of Medicine and Psychology of Sapienza - University of Rome, since september 2017. In the period 2005-2017 she was Researcher in SSD M-PSI/04 (Developmental and Educational Psychology) in the same University. She is member of Department of Developmental and Social Psychology at Sapienza, University of Rome. Currently she teaches "Developmental Assessment Techniques" and "Educational Psychology" at Rome University "Sapienza". Previously she has taught "Life span psychology", "Adolescence, adulthood and old age psychology", "Developmental Psychodiagnosis", "Developmental Assessment Instruments" and "Psychological Tests" at the same university as well as "Developmental Psychology" at the University of L'Aquila and "Social Developmental Psychology" at the University of Chieti "G. D'Annunzio". She is director of Master in Developmental Psychodiagnosis (Sapienza, University of Rome) and assistant director of the Post graduate School in Lifespan Developmental Psychology (director prof. F. Laghi). Since 2002 she is member of Italian Association of Psychologists – AIP, Section Development and education. She is specialized in clinical psychology and psychotherapy and as such she is enlisted in the Italian Albo degli Psicologi. She has participated to several national research projects, in particular on children's socialization and the use of drawing as a tool in psychodiagnostic assessment. She is director of the Service for the Assessment and support for child development (Se.Va.S.S.), Department of Psychology of the developmental and socialization processes of Rome.
